

SELECT BOOKS

The reading level of a book is only one factor to consider when helping your child select a book. Be sure to consider your child's interests, motivation and maturity, the book's themes and ideas as well as whether your child is reading for learning or pleasure.

What are Lexile measures?

Lexile measures describe a student's reading ability and are often reported on state testing results that might look like "900L". Lexile measures range from below OL for beginning readers and texts to above 1600L for advanced readers and texts. You can find your child's Lexile measure in year-end state test reports as well as from other classroom tests and reading programs. Or, ask your child's teacher. It's not necessary to know your child's Lexile measure to use Find a Book.
